Ice skating judge gets one step closer to her Olympic dream

When she started skating in 1977, Devonport local Sue Petrecevic could never have foreseen an Olympic future in her sport. But that is exactly where she is headed with the help of a \$10,000 scholarship from Rothbury Risk & Investment and AMP.

Currently an International Ice Skating Judge for New Zealand Sue is one of four New Zealanders qualified to judge at events except the Worlds and Olympic competitions.

But she's not stopping there. Sue wants to be an Olympic judge with the 2014 Winter Olympics, Sochi Russia, in her sights.

To achieve her Olympic dream Sue must be accepted into and pass the International Skating Union (ISU) exam. After 4 years fulfilling qualifications, this year she is eligible to sit the exam. The \$10,000 scholarship will go towards expenses for the exam, seminars and competitions she needs to attend in order to judge at the Olympics.

Rothbury Risk & Investment, in partnership with AMP, award the scholarship each year and received 100s of applications from talented kiwis.
